RESPONSIBILITIES:

Performs a variety of skilled and unskilled maintenance work in the construction, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of the District's water distribution and metering, wastewater collection systems. Maintains water and wastewater systems, constructs new water and wastewater taps. Ensures continuous, effective operation of the District's water and sewer system by repairing, installing and relocating water and sewer lines. Maintains safe and efficient operation of machines and equipment. Provides customer services in response to citizens' questions and/or complaints. Assists crew chief operator in effectively completing daily tasks. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

High School Graduate or GED Certificate. Must pass pre-employment physical, back x-ray, and pass drug testing. Must possess valid Texas Class C Driver's License. Ability to obtain at least a Grade D Water and Class I Wastewater Collection Certificate from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) within one (1) year of employment. Ability to obtain a Grade C Water Distribution and Class II Wastewater Collection Certificate within three (3) years of employment. Must abide by all policies and procedures covered within The Water Company handbook.
