

# Free Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Now Available for Water District Customers



**Free hazardous waste and electronics recycling services are now available for Dickinson's water district residential customers at the Stella Roberts Recycling Center in Pearland. This service is offered through a partnership with the nonprofit Keep Pearland Beautiful.**

Customers must bring a copy of their WCID #1 water bill and valid photo ID showing a residential address that matches the address listed on the WCID #1 water bill to qualify.

In addition to standard recyclables such as metals, glass, paper, cardboard, and plastics #1-5 and 7, the following are free to recycle for WCID #1 residential customers:

- Latex and oil-based paints, varnishes and sealants
- Small and large appliances
- Televisions, computers, monitors and accessories
- Household chemicals, such as pool and lawn chemicals, household cleaning products, and poisons including herbicides and pest/insecticides
- Batteries – All types
- Cooking oil, motor oil and car fluids – Up to 10 gallons



**Appointments are required to drop off household hazardous waste only, not for all other recyclables. No commercial recycling allowed.**
