

Green Waste Guidelines

Please follow these guidelines when disposing of yard waste and trimmings to ensure it is picked up.

The District's contract with AmeriWaste DOES NOT include picking up any storm-related debris, regardless of whether it is loose, bagged, or bundled.

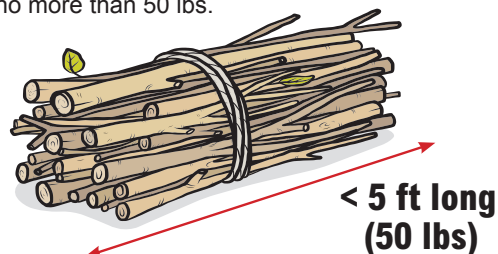

Place your yard trimming (leaves, grass, yard and garden clippings) in bags of adequate strength. Bags should weigh no more than 50 lbs.

50 lb limit
(per bag)



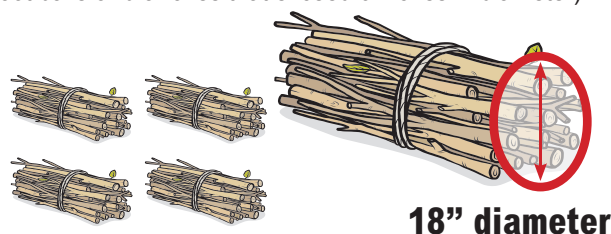
Branches, brush, and similar woody material should be bundled and tied in lengths not exceeding 5 feet, and should weigh no more than 50 lbs.



Only 4 bags are allowed per household per pickup.



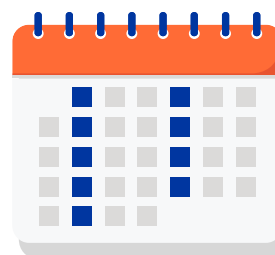
Bundles should not exceed 18 inches in diameter. No more than 4 bundles will be picked up (does not include tree trunks, root balls or branches that exceed 6 inches in diameter).



Leaves and woody materials will NOT be picked up if they are not bagged.



Green waste is collected during regular trash pickup.



The Public Utility Commission's rule in Title 16, Chapter 24 Texas Admin. Code § 24.173(d) prohibits Galveston County WCID #1 from imposing a late fee or from disconnecting your retail water or sewer service for nonpayment of bills that are due during an extreme weather emergency until after the emergency is over.
