1. Discussion of Water and Sewer Rates.

General Manager Ivan Langford gave an overview of the proposed Water and Sewer Rates.

Secretary-Treasurer Bill Gaffey questioned which option that the FY2021-22 budget is based on, and Chief Financial Officer Aurora Amaro stated that the FY2021-22 is based on Option 1.

Chief Financial Officer Aurora Amaro reported that Option 1 generates \$920,045 in revenues, and she reported that Option 2 generates \$797,970 in revenues.

She also reviewed the "Summarized Schedule of Budget Changes and Updates", showing expenses adjusted as of 09/20/2021 of \$12,461,268.

Chief Financial Officer Aurora Amaro answered Board of Directors' questions and concerns.
